



Application for a director identification number – for people living in Australia

The fastest way to apply for a director identification number (director ID) is online at abrs.gov.au/directorIDapply.

Use this application form if an Australian Business Registry Services (ABRS) contact officer has requested you to complete it, and you live in Australia.

To prevent processing delays, make sure you answer all questions.

If we can confirm your details with our systems, we'll issue you a director ID and give you the number in writing.

When completing this form:

- answer all questions, otherwise we may need to contact you for more information
- print clearly, using a black or dark blue pen
- use BLOCK LETTERS and print one character in each box
- write an 'X' in all applicable boxes
- don't use correction fluid or covering stickers
- read the privacy statement and sign the declaration at the end of the form
- provide acceptable proof of identity documents – see Section D of this form.

! It's not an offence if you don't provide your TFN. However, providing your TFN and the identity documents in Section D will help us verify your identity. The Registrar is authorised by the *Corporations Act 2001* and the *Corporations (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander) Act 2006* to request your TFN.

Section B: Application requirements

You can apply for a director ID if you are:

- an eligible officer, or
- intend to become an eligible officer within 12 months after applying.

An eligible officer is an appointed director or alternate director (acting in that capacity) of a company or body corporate that is a registered Australian body or registered foreign company, or an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander corporation.

The Registrar may make a determination that a particular person or class of persons are not eligible officers.

You should not apply for a director ID if you already have an active director ID, unless the Registrar has directed you to.

To be eligible to be a director, you must:

- be an individual,
- be at least 18 years of age; and
- not be disqualified from managing corporations unless your appointment is made with the permission of the Australian Securities & Investments Commission (ASIC), Office of the Registrar of Indigenous Corporations (ORIC), or with leave of the Court.

Primary documents:

- Australian full birth certificate (extracts and commemorative certificates are not acceptable)
- Australian passport (including passports that have expired in the last 3 years)
- Australian citizenship certificate or extract from a Register of Citizenship by Descent
- foreign passport.

Secondary documents:

- Medicare card
- Australian driver's licence or Australian learner's permit. This must show your photo and signature. The address must match the details on your application.

If you have changed your name, you must provide another document showing the change, such as a marriage certificate, deed poll or change of name certificate.
