PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do hereby declare that I have this day assented, in Her Majesty's name, to the Bill passed by the Parliament of the said State, the title whereof is hereunder set forth, together with the short title, that is to say:

No. 10203 "An Act to enable the constitutional arrangements affecting the Commonwealth and the States to be brought into conformity with the status of the Commonwealth of Australia as a sovereign, independent and federal nation." (*Australia Acts (Requests) Act 1985*).

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this sixth day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighty-five and in the thirty-fourth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.
